The participants of the TAIEX Programme (TAIEX – Technical Assistance Information Exchange) are candidate countries for acceding the European Union (EU), potential candidate countries for acceding the EU and countries included in the EU's European Neighbourhood Policy.

In the Republic of Belarus this Programme is funded from the European Neighbourhood and Partnership Instrument (ENPI) Interregional Programme.

The TAIEX Programme is financing short term and mobile projects which can be prepared and implemented within a matter of weeks.

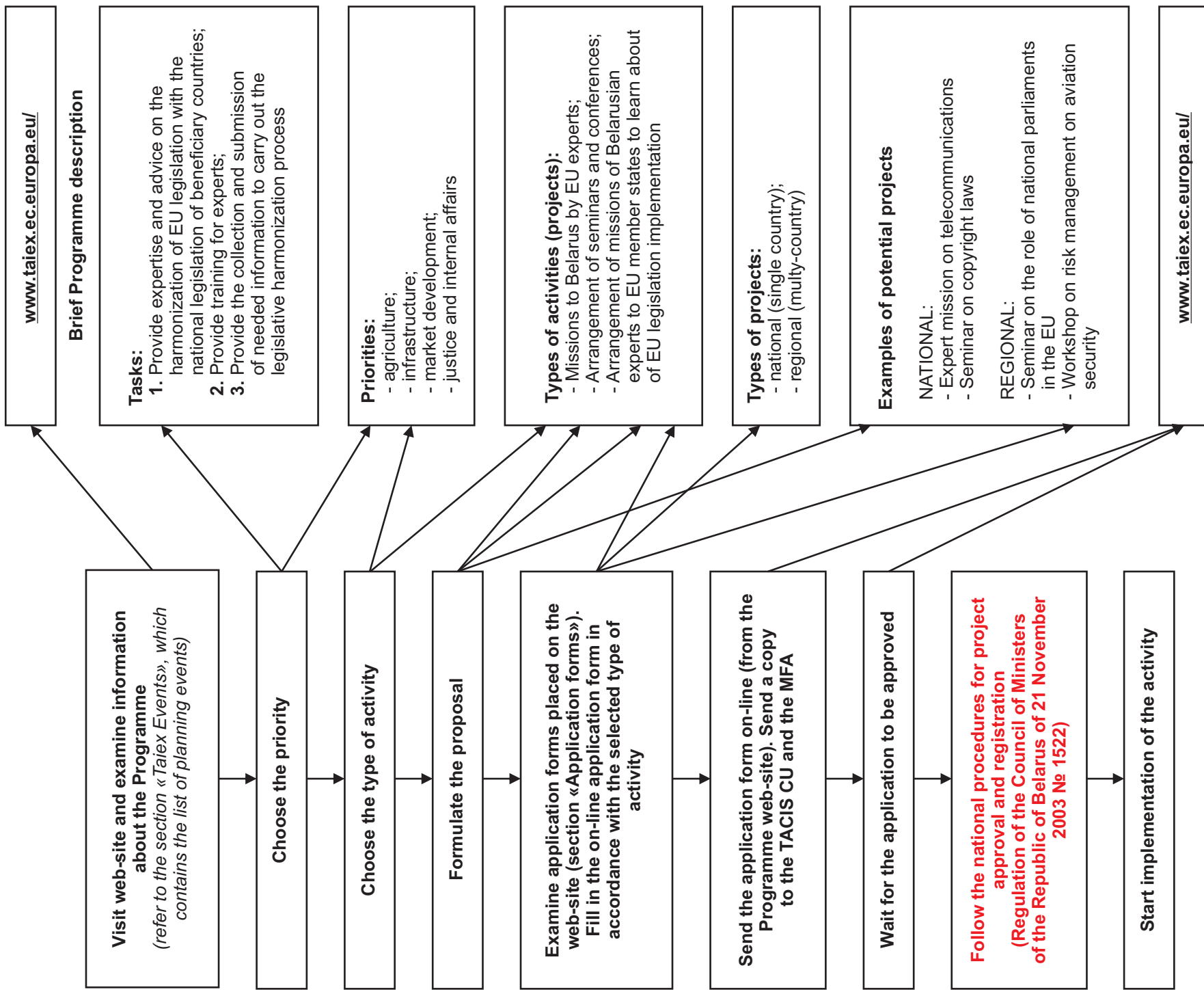
